After extremely cold weather kept us from gathering for our parking lot Communion service in February, we are once again ready to come together for worship. Please join us in the south parking lot of Two Rivers Church on Sunday, March 7 at 2pm for another Parking Lot Communion service. Tune in to radio station 94.1 FM and follow along as Pastor Robb leads us in observing the sacraments of Holy Communion. Everyone will be required to remain in their vehicles.

As always, the focus of the service will be the full Communion liturgy. The elements will be prepared in pre-packaged cups and distributed to people who remain in their parked cars. In addition to the Communion Liturgy there will be music, Communion hymns, and a short devotional.

This service will be in addition to our weekly Worship at Home videos. The videos will continue to be released at 9:30 a.m. every Sunday on Facebook Live and our church website.



Lenten Journey Continues

Over the next several weeks of Lent we will continue to ask the important question of “Who?” as we travel through the Gospel of Luke. We will hear his story of lost coins, sheep, and a son, and wonder, “Who is lost?”. We will learn about the rich man and Lazarus and think about, “Who we can tell?”. We will read the story of Jesus and Zacchaeus the tax collector and ask, “Who can we invite?”

Lent is a chance to look deeper into our faith, dive deeper in the Scriptures, and pray deeper with God. To help you on this journey the Evangelism Team has put together Lent bags that have been mailed to members of Two Rivers. These bags include a Lenten Devotional Guide written by Pastor Robb, along with small items that will act as object lessons for each of the Sundays in Lent. The devotional includes daily readings and reflections to last through Easter Sunday, April 4.

HOLY WEEK

Maundy Thursday and Good Friday will be presented online. Our Maundy Thursday service will be on Facebook Live and our Website at 6:00 p.m. on April 1. The Maundy Thursday service will be co-produced by Two Rivers and the Church of Peace UCC. Much like the Ash Wednesday service, clergy, musicians, and laity from both churches will participate in the service.

The Good Friday service will be a quiet service of reflection presented on Facebook Live and our website at 6:00 p.m. on April 2.

On Easter Sunday we will gather in the south parking lot for a time of live worship on April 4 at 2:00 p.m. Pastor Robb will be outside with a speaker system. Guests are required to remain masked and physically distant but are invited to bring a lawn chair and gather outside their cars to be a part of worship. In case of rain, the sound system and speakers will move inside and broadcast via FM radio as we have done with the Parking Lot Communion services.

Music at our "tailgate" Easter will be pre-recorded, and if you prefer to remain in your car during the service, that will be an option as well. There will be room to spill-over into the west parking lot if the south parking lot gets full.

This will not replace the Easter Worship at Home video. Easter at Home will still be on Facebook Live and our Website at 9:30 a.m.

NEWS FROM AFRICA UNIVERSITY

Please hold Africa University (AU) staff and students in your prayers.

Africa University is the first and only fully accredited institution of higher learning established on the African continent by action of the General Conference of the United Methodist Church. During the COVID-19 pandemic, Africa University has provided online classes, as well as, housing and meals for international students who could not go home due to COVID restrictions. A group of these international students organized a Feed a Family campaign to donate food and money to communities in need during the pandemic.

While Missionary Larry Kies has officially retired, he continues to teach at AU on a volunteer basis, and his wife, Jane, still works as a United Methodist missionary in her capacity of teaching English as a second language. They remain healthy and thank us for our encouragement and prayers.

The AU community has suffered several tragedies over the last few months. Last August, the newly elected President of the AU board, Bishop John Yambasu from Sierra Leone, was killed in a vehicle accident. On January 13, Vice Chancellor Munashe Furusa died suddenly after being taken to the hospital in Mutare. He was 59. Vice Chancellor Furusa served in several university roles both in the United States and Zimbabwe, and was well-respected. Vice Chancellor Furusa graciously met with the 2019 IGRC mission team of which Claudia and Bob Applegate were a part, and graciously spent time answering the team's questions. On January 15, Patrick Matsikenyiri, the AU choir director and music teacher, died from COVID complications at the hospital in Mutare. He developed the 4-year music education program at AU, the only 4-year music degree program in all of sub-Saharan Africa. He was much loved by his students and led the AU choir on several trips to the States. All these men were courageous, innovative leaders and excellent educators, and will be greatly missed.

We also request prayers for the children, house mothers, and administrative staff at the Fairfield Children's Home in Old Mutare. At least two house mothers have been infected with the COVID-19 virus, and one has reportedly died.
