DAILY BIBLE READINGS

The Hebrew word for "faithful love" or "mercy" in Psalm 23:6 is "hessed." It appears 247 times in the Hebrew Bible. Here are seven examples.

Saturday	Micah 6:6-8	God requires hessed

Read again slowly, if a word makes you pause, linger there. 3. Meditate over that word. 4. Be silent, allow God to speak. 5. Consider your response to this word.
