#### Rock Island Line Podcast





The Two Rivers Readers had a wonderful time last month discussing the book, "Remarkably Bright Creatures" and eating from a buffet of adorable octopus themed treats.




The group will also meet on **October 27** to discuss a shorter book, *Save Me the Plums: My*
