PASTOR ROBB'S NOTES

I told you we would speed through Mark. As we enter Matthew, notice how similar it is, but also make comparisons to see how different it is. What is highlighted? What are Matthew's themes? Matthew uses Scripture much more than Mark, and the conflict is more centered on the Pharisees.

The saga of Abraham is well underway now. These are origin stories - both of Israel and their enemies. Notice how the Moabites are explained and the complicated history with the Philistines. This ends with Abraham living in a foreign land. It is an interesting contrast to Joshua, which is not the most exiting reading. It is mostly explaining the boundaries of the different tribes, but at the end, the concept of “refuge cities” is fascinating.
