PASTOR ROBB'S NOTES

The Torah tract starts with one of the most controversial stories of the entire Bible. Gallons of ink have been spilled over this troubling text. One thing I want to point: Abraham and God do not talk directly to each other again.

In the Prophets tract, we draw Joshua to a close. The land is possessed, and Joshua gives a warning to remember why they were given the Land - to worship God and to be faithful. As George Washington says in *Hamilton*, "Winning was easy. Governing is harder."

Hopefully the Matthew readings are familiar. It includes the Sermon on the Mount, but from here on you will be reading the rest of the story.

Oh yeah, and Psalm 23 is awesome.
