PASTOR ROBB'S NOTES

In the Torah portion we learn of Moses and in the Prophets we inch toward David. These are arguably the two most important figures in the Hebrew bible. Moses' origin story includes bravery of several women, and we also read the incredible "burning bush." In Samuel the people beg for a King, and all the things God warns about will eventually come true.

In Luke, we hear the "Sermon on the Plain," which should sound familiar. Comparing and contrasting it to Matthew 5-7 is a worthy endeavor. As you read Luke, notice all the times when a man and woman are paired in the storytelling.
