PASTOR ROBB’S NOTES

The details about sacrifices and offerings can be tedious, but it does help paint a picture of Judaism before and during the Temple. An important thing to notice is how many different kinds of offerings there are.

In 2 Samuel, the House of David is full of intrigue and betrayal. David has a civil war on his hands as his sons go to war and the death of Absalom is a crushing blow. We wrap up Acts and see that the Gospel has reached “the end of the earth,” which is Rome and then start Paul’s letter to the Romans.
