PASTOR ROBB'S NOTES

The purity code in Leviticus is heating up - with a lot of seemingly bizarre prohibitions. Remember the complexity and peculiarity of this code the next time someone tries to use Leviticus to exclude LGBTQ people from the Kingdom. In the prophets, King Solomon takes center-stage and we see his triumphs and his failures. He is known for wisdom and wealth, but it is his failures that divide the kingdom. We very neatly wrap up Paul's letter to the Romans, and take note of his final instructions - which will be repeated in most of his letters. That is, "be good to each other."
