### PASTOR ROBB'S NOTES

These chapters in Leviticus include some important laws concerning social justice that prohibit economic exploitation and are meant to prevent economic stratification. Numbers is often where people hoping to read the Bible cover-to-cover slip up. In 1 Kings we get alternating accounts of the kings of Judah and Israel. We are also introduced to the prophet Elijah. His story is fascinating, and very important to know if you want to understand Jesus. We then start Paul's letter to the Corinthians. As we read these letters you must remember that they are addressed to a specific people with real problems. This is Paul's practical theology, which isn't always systematically consistent.
