PASTOR ROBB'S NOTES

TORAH: Israel nears the end of its wilderness journey as judgment, census, and succession unfold. Balaam's blessing gives way to Israel's unfaithfulness, yet God keeps ordering the community for life in the land.

PROPHETS: Judah's final kings face collapse as Assyria and Babylon close in. Even moments of reform can't stop the fall, and by week's end Jerusalem is destroyed and the people are carried into exile.

NEW TESTAMENT: Paul closes one letter and launches another, defending the gospel's freedom and his own calling. He confronts division, insists on life in the Spirit, and urges the churches to live out the new creation.
