PASTOR ROBB'S NOTES

TORAH: Israel wraps up its wilderness years with battles, boundaries, and final instructions. As the tribes settle their claims and Moses begins retelling the story, God keeps shaping a people ready to enter the land with clarity and purpose.

PROPHETS: Isaiah opens with a searing call to repentance as Judah's worship and justice fall apart. Judgment looms, yet glimmers of hope appear — a purified remnant, a coming sign, and the promise that God is not finished with this people.

NEW TESTAMENT: Paul celebrates the grace that has brought believers from death to life and bound them into one new humanity. He urges a Spirit-shaped way of living — in unity, holiness, and mutual love — and begins his joyful partnership with the Philippians.
