PASTOR ROBB'S NOTES

TORAH: Moses lays out practices of worship, and community responsibility, shaping Israel into a people who protect the vulnerable, and honor God in every aspect of life.

PROPHETS: Isaiah warns Jerusalem and the nations of pride, complacency, and false security, yet promises God's ultimate reign and the defeat of all that threatens life.

WRITINGS: Proverbs contrasts wise restraint with destructive speech, tempers, and desires, urging humility, patience, generosity, and integrity as the way to a grounded and flourishing life.

NEW TESTAMENT: 1 Timothy is a tough book, and probably wasn't written by Paul. There is some beauty, but there is also ugliness found in this letter.
