The SOUND of MUSIC



A tuneful, heartwarming story, it is based on the real life story of the Von Trapp Family singers, one of the world's best-known concert groups in the era immediately preceding World War II. The story centers on Maria, the tomboyish postulant at an Austrian abbey who becomes a governess in the home of a widowed naval captain with seven children, and brings a new love of life and music into the home.



Dolores Sierra: The first live theater experience I had was at the age of 11, when I saw the Sound of Music in Peoria, IL. It. Was. Magical. I never dreamed I would eventually be onstage, but the list includes Mame, (twice); Fiddler on the Roof (as oldest daughter Tzeitel, Mama Golde, and

Grandma Tzeitel, three different productions); Side by Side by Sondheim, musical revue; Carousel as Julie; It's a Wonderful Life, Ma Bailey; The Happy Time as a daughter; Unsinkable Molly Brown, ensemble; 9 to 5, Roz; Little Women as Marmee; Sister Act as the oldest nun in the convent; and Sound of Music as Mother Abbess. Sound of Music was the last show I was in and I figure it's a full circle now.
