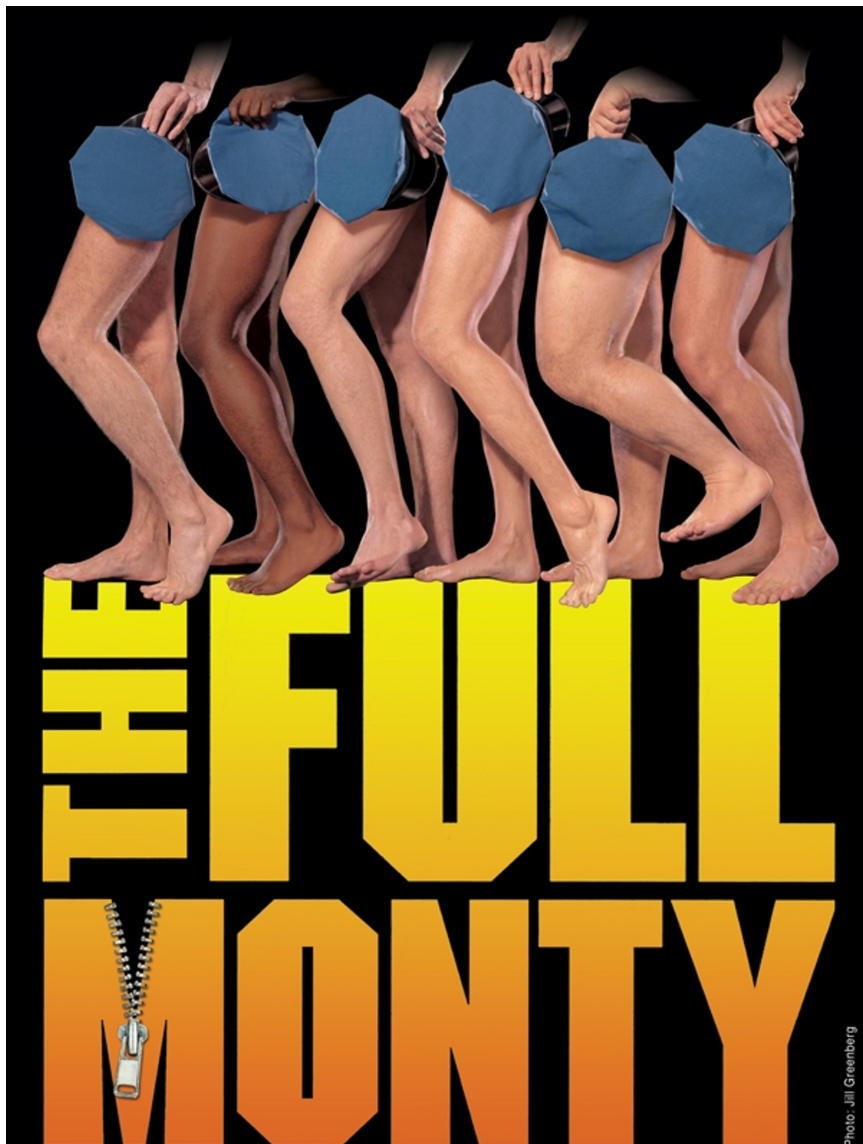


PLAYBILL
