The story of Jacob is fascinating, rich, and so important as a foundational origin story of our faith. Jacob literally becomes Israel this week. From the "Heel" to the one who "Wrestles with God," Jacob's relationships and dealing with Esau, Rachel, and Laban all come to a dramatic climax. This is great stuff.

The chapters from Judges are not as memorable as Genesis, but Deborah is worth noting. Also, the stories of the loose band of tribes coming together to form a people is important to understanding Israel's history.

Things really get rolling in Matthew, two mass-feedings, a bunch of parables, and more conflict with the Pharisees. Next week things really heat up, but this is laying the groundwork with some difficult teachings.
